## Applications are available at the gallery.

#### **EXHIBITOR FEES**

- 1. Applications must be mailed or placed in Festival mailbox at the shop.
- 2. Application must include a booth space fee check.
  - Artist 10' x 10' Booth Fee \$197.50
  - Artist Double 10' x 20' Booth Fee \$395.00
- **3.** If you are accepted, your booth fee will be cashed on **June 11th.**
- 4. If you want to share your booth with an artist that is not a member of the gallery, that artist must submit a full application, pay a jury fee, and half the non-member artist booth fee:
  - Submit separate applications.
  - Non-member pays \$35 jury fee with a separate check.
  - Submits 3 images of their work.
  - Non-member pays Artist Half Booth Fee: \$197.50
  - Member pays Artist Half Booth Fee: \$ 98.75
- 5. Booth Fee for applications received after the jury meets in May, 2023 \$212.50

### **JURY PROCESS REQUIRES FOUR IMAGES**

- 1. Member Image Requirements and Request
  - Images of your art that you do sell in the gallery are helpful for jury to compare to other applicants and for advertising and FaceBook posts.
- 2. For applications for your art not currently shown in the gallery send an email or 3-4 jpg images for each medium to:festival@commonwheel.com

#### **IMAGES FOR JURY TO REVIEW & PUBLICITY**

- After submitting an application, send 3 images to: festival@commonwheel.com.
- Email Subject Line: (Your Name) Member Fest App Images.
- Images should show your work clearly against a solid
- Images should show your work clearly against a solid color background. One item per image.
- Images showing the quality of your most current work.
- Images should be 300 dpi & no smaller than 6" x 8".
- Use a descriptive name for each image.

#### **ACCEPTANCE**

- 1. All artwork is juried by digital jpg images.
- 2. Images must be current and representative of your art.
- **3.** Jurors look for work that is well conceived, expertly executed and exhibits imagination and originality.
- **4.** All art displayed at the Festival must be the artist's own, high quality, original art similar to what was juried in.
  - Selection of exhibitors remains the exclusive right of the Commonwheel Artists Co-op and the results are final.

#### **COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS**

The Commonwheel Festival will follow all regulations set in place relating to COVID-19 by the state and city government agencies to assure all participating artists, our volunteers and the art patrons who come to festival will be safe.

#### ARTIST BOOTH SPACES

- 1. Artist booth spaces are 10'x10'.
- 2. Floor mats, carpets, and ground stakes are not allowed.
- **3.** Artists are responsible for the set up and removal of their displays and equipment and disposal of trash.
- **4.** Anyone misrepresenting work to be displayed or breaking any rule may be asked to leave by a Festival Committee representative. *No refunds will be made.*

#### **SALES TAX**

- **1.** Commonwheel Artists Festival holds a CO Multiple Event License.
- 2. Artists must collect 9.03% sales tax on all their sales.
- **4.** Artists must pay all State, City & County sales taxes on Monday, Sept. 4, 2023, starting at 5pm at the Information Booth.
- **3.** Artists and food vendors are responsible for collecting sales tax on each sale.

#### ARTIST DEMONSTRATIONS

If you wish to demonstrate, please note on your application. If a demonstration is approved, a waiver of Commonwheel's responsibility for any accidents or injuries must be provided by the artist. The artist must provide a certificate of liability insurance naming the City of Manitou Springs and Commonwheel Artists Co-op as co-insured.
